

Annual Subscriptions 2024-2025



We hope that you are looking forward to the new season of St Asaph Choral Society in September. Emerging from Covid, the committee made bold decisions to keep costs to a minimum and to use reserve funds to underwrite the choir's activity. This has had the desired effect of ensuring the choir is back up and singing in our community.

However, this arrangement is not sustainable for the long-term future. We are taking a proactive approach to address this. Alongside seeking out grant funding for our concerts and rehearsal schedule, we are taking the opportunity to review the annual subscription. The full subscription fee for the coming year will be £50 per term. This can be paid to the society as a one off payment of £100 in September, or in two payments of £50 (September and January). We recognise that this will be a significant increase for some of our members, and are therefore introducing the option of paying the subscription by a monthly standing order, of £8.50/month, over 12 months. Fees at this level will simply cover the cost of our weekly rehearsals. The committee are also keen to ensure that paying the full subscription should not be a barrier to any member wanting to join us or sing with us. We have therefore set some money aside to help fund subscriptions for those who may struggle, including young people, those from low income households, unemployed and those in receipt of benefits.
